
If a student hasn't met target progress for 2 weeks, I speak with the student. If it continues, I email their teacher.

To assist the students with class assignments, I try to circulate frequently and ask how things are going. Also, I ask if anyone needs help with their computers, i.e., uploading, downloading, printing.

Thus far, students have needed help creating accounts, choosing classes, downloading docs, unlocking tests, etc.

Staying on task and not talking to neighbors seem to be most common problems I deal with.

I also periodically check on students work in Remote Desktop.
