Students will apply through the Pasco Pathways application process in myStudent.

The Collegiate High School Program:

- is designed to allow students to earn an AA/AS Degree or a CAPE Industry Certification while also earning their standard high school diploma;
- provides students priority when enrolling in PHSC courses by allowing them to register at the same time as all other fee-paying PHSC students;
- requires students to be full-time at PHSC; accepted students will not take any courses on the high school campus;
- allows accepted students to still be considered a student of their zoned high school and to participate in their zoned school athletics, student activities and graduation ceremonies.
